

Mercer Dishwasher Sanitizer

- DESCRIPTION:** A pale yellow, clear liquid having a chlorine odour for sanitizing and bleaching. For use in low and high temp dishwashers where a chlorine sanitizer is needed
- USE:** As a disinfecting solution containing 100 ppm of chlorine use 1.85 ml per litre of water. As a laundry bleach use approximately 6 ml per litre of water.
- INGREDIENTS:** Sodium Hypochlorite 6% by trade; Sodium Hydroxide less than 1%

- HAZARDS:** Concentrate is corrosive to skin, eyes, membranes.
- PRECAUTIONS:** Will attack silk, wool, leather, non-fast colours, aluminum, silver and iron.
- Will release dangerous chlorine gas or fumes if mixed with toilet bowl cleaners, acids or ammonia.
- Avoid contact with eyes, skin. Do not take internally. Dilute with water before using.
- FIRST AID:** Call a physician.
- ON SKIN:** Wash off with ample water.
- IN EYES:** Wash with running water for at least 15 minutes
- INTERNAL:** Take whites of 2 eggs in a glass of milk.
- STORAGE:** Store upright in original container. Containers have a gas- releasing vent at the top. Keep cool and away from sunlight or heat.
- DISPOSAL:** Emergency: Dilute with ample water.
